


Diversity Workbench

The Diversity Workbench Modules within the framework of the GBIF-D Node for Mycology

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The *Diversity Workbench* modules that were developed within the BIOLOG-project GLOPP are upgraded and adapted to the demands of the GBIF-D Node for Mycology. The necessary modules To enable the extension of the modular approach of the *Diversity Workbench* on Unix databases and to ensure the interoperability with other GBIF-projects, a middle tier is developed.


The existing *Diversity Workbench* database modules are going to be extended, and will be established under Microsoft SQL-Server and PostgreSQL. The project is organized as a network of small workpackages, some are upcoming, some in progress and others already completed.
